THE ACT - USE OF PLANT

Duties of employers

Ensuring that any plant or substance provided for use by the employees at work is safe and without risks to health when properly used.

The Regulations

The Regulation clearly spells out that the hazard identification, risk assessment and control process is to be followed with Plant items.

Why do I need to conduct plant hazard assessments?

There are many reasons why undertaking plant hazards assessments is crucial for anyone involved in the supply or operation of plant & equipment:

1. **Reduced incidents and injuries**
2. **Reduced likelihood of prosecution**
3. **Plus more**

Reduced Likelihood of Prosecution

Risk assessment and control are the fundamental building blocks of all modern safety systems. Occupational Health and Safety legislation in every State and Territory of Australia, along with Commonwealth safety legislation requires employers to follow the process of:

- **Hazard Identification**
- **Risk Assessment**
- **Risk Control**
